We have just started to examine and brush away the 'desert sand' for artefacts- nothing yet!




In computing sessions, we started by listening to music inspired by the Ancient Egyptians and we are now using the Isle of Tunes app to create our own piece of Egyptian music. It has been exciting to use technology to compose music.

Our literacy focus was on writing persuasive letters. We certainly have worked hard learning all about paragraphing, using rhetorical questions and writing a range of different sentences - simple, compound and complex.

Geometric reasoning, place value and telling the time have been our three main focuses in Maths. We are also continuing to challenge ourselves to learn our times tables and associated division facts.

During our Science lessons, we have discovered the three functions of our skeleton and named the bones in our body. We were very excited to take part in a challenging investigation to find out if taller people have the biggest bones. We had to use team work for this. Probably our biggest Science challenge was when we dissected chicken wings to look at the bones, muscles and tendons - definitely not a job for the squeamish!
