



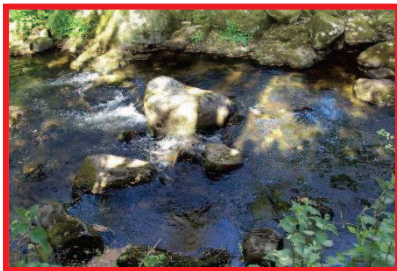

Here are some of the highlights from the beginning of this term.



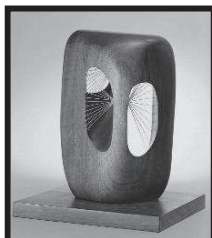
In Science, we have started a new and exciting topic on 'Rocks and Fossils'. So far, we have been out and about exploring our local area to

see what different types of rocks we could find.

In art, we have been learning all about Barbara Hepworth. We began by finding out all about her life and where she found her inspiration. Now we have started creating some of our own sculptures based on her work.



Here we are painting our sculptures ready to thread colourful string through the holes we have created.



Our maths work has also taken us outside as we've been looking at shapes, angles and symmetry. We used the natural environment to help us learn about these. It was great using chalk to create symmetrical patterns and also work on co-ordinates.
