



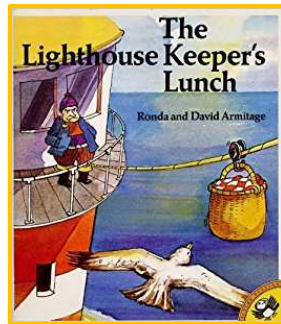
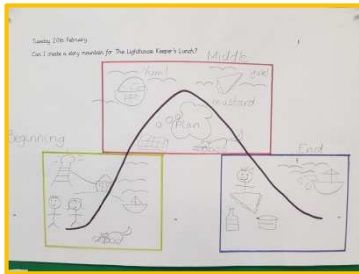
# Hedgehogs

We had a lovely time dressing up for world book day as our favourite characters. It was fun to share different stories and look at a variety of books.



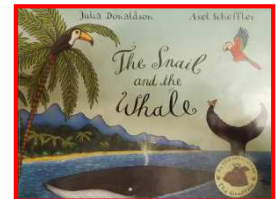
