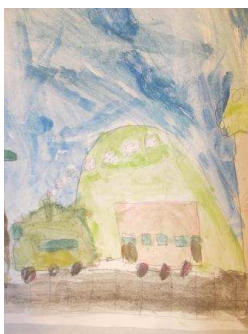
We drew the engine called 'Lady Angela' and the carriages. We used our sketches to help us paint pictures back in class.



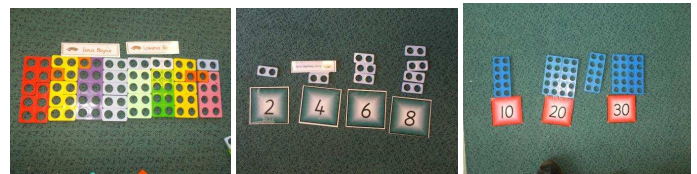

helped us to develop our writing by using adjectives. Here are paintings of our train journey by Conner and Freya.



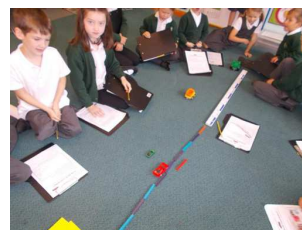
In maths we have been learning about number bonds to 10 and 20, and using numicon to help count in 2s and 10s.
