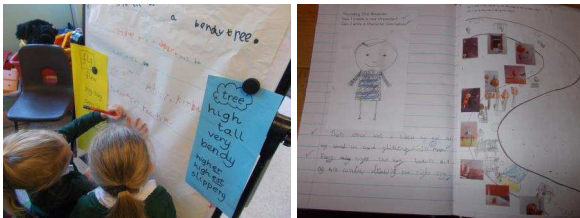

We have been reading and acting out the story 'How to Catch a Star' by Oliver Jeffers.

We used adjectives and adverbs to add description and details to the text and then used the story as a basis for our own stories.



In science we have been investigating the seasons, months and how the weather changes through the year. We went for an autumn walk to Longtimber Woods and looked at the viaduct and the old swimming pool. We found objects that were rough, smooth, spiky, shiny or round and used these to write descriptive sentences.

coins ... dice and ... other resources.

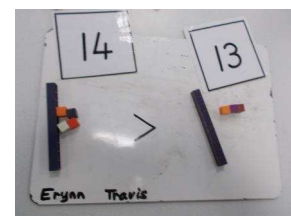


Many year 2s were able to count up and record numbers over 100!
