Plastic Free Ivybridge

Many of you will have seen the local news that Ivybridge is hoping to become a plastic free town. This campaign has been set up to try and reduce the amount of 'single use plastics' that are used and discarded in the community causing environmental damage. We are very keen to support this and cut down on the waste. Single-use plastics, or disposable plastics, are used only once before they are thrown away or recycled. These items are things like plastic bags, straws, coffee stirrers, soda and water bottles and most food packaging. We produce roughly 300 million tons of plastic each year and half of it is disposable!
