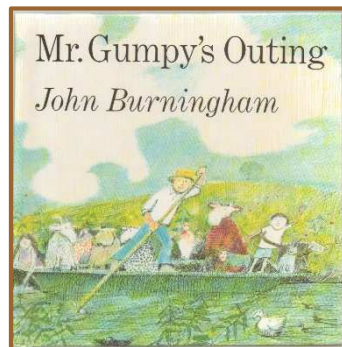
Class News
