We have been looking at the Eric Carle book, *The Very Mixed up Chameleon*. Which included talking about a chameleon changing colour as it moved onto different coloured places



The children explored this camouflage trick hiding different coloured chameleons by matching their colour.

Can you spot the orange chameleon?

In **Maths** the children, like the chameleon in the story, chose the animal they would like to be. They recorded their choice against the animal then we counted and recorded the number of tally marks. The favourite animal was the Polar Bear.
