- **If you have recently moved in from abroad and want to check if your child requires a BCG vaccination, please contact your school nurse for further information.**



- **All children under the age of 16 are eligible for free dental care and vision checks. Children should have their teeth checked at least annually and their eyes tested every two years, or more often if indicated.**
