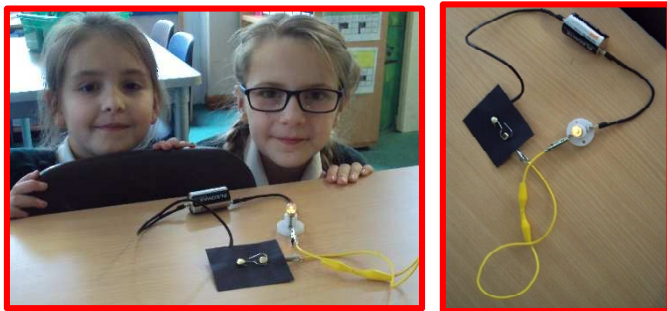

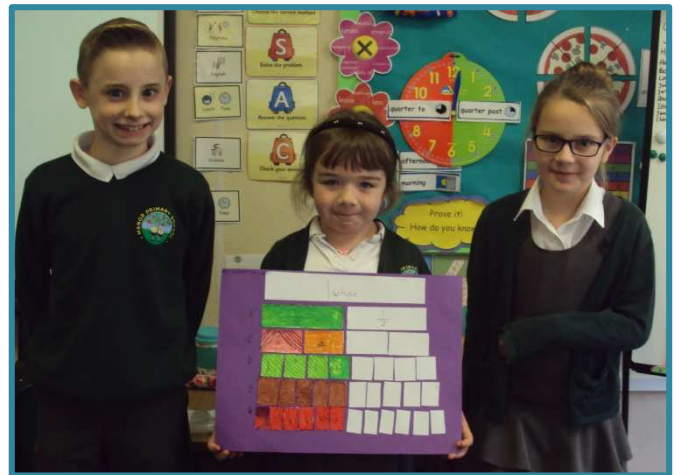


We even had a go at making our own switches using cardboard, split pins and paper clips!
