We then had a go at painting our very own pebbles. Here are some of our colourful creations...



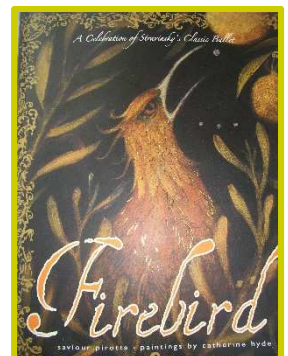
In art, we have been learning about Barbara Hepworth. We began by finding out all about her life and where she found her inspiration. Now we have started creating some of our own sculptures based on her work.
