In literacy lessons, we have been reading the story of the 'Lighthouse Keepers Lunch.' We made sandwiches just like Mrs Grinling did in the story. We also went outside and tried to use rope and string to carry the basket across the play area.

The weather has been very mixed this term but we have tried to make the most of it, sledging in the snow and playing hide and seek in the secret garden in the sunshine.



We have made some fantastic bird feeders – bird feeder kebabs and some yoghurt pot feeders.

In science we have been learning about what plants need to grow and labelling parts of a plant.



We have been on a plant hunt and taken photographs of different plants and flowers.

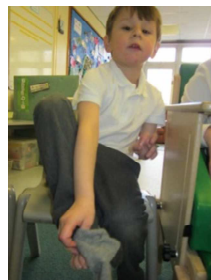
In our art sessions we have been painting cardboard roll lighthouse and then sculpting them out of clay. We have painted flowers and made collages of daffodils.



In maths we have learning about number. The Foundation children have been practising counting up to 5, 10 and 20. They have enjoyed making repeating patterns and building and matching shapes. The Year One and Two children have been learning about multiplication and adding and subtracting up to 20 and 50. They have enjoyed naming 2D and 3D shapes and talking



about the sides, faces and corners of the shapes.



In our basic skills sessions we have been learning how to brush our teeth and wash our hands correctly. We have also learned how to put on our shoes and socks.
