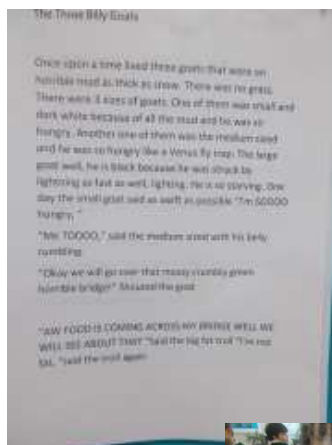

In our literacy lessons, the Key Stage One children have been reading stories with repetitive language. They made simple flap books just like Dear Zoo and learnt the name of the animals.

After they had read the hungry caterpillar the children were encouraged to try some new fruits such as kiwi and plums.



They have also been improving their fine motor skills by threading beads to make caterpillar models.



Children in year 5/6 have been learning about the structure and content of traditional fairytales.

In art we have been looking at famous portraits and learning how to draw our own.



During our Science lessons, some of the children have been learning about forces and in particular air and water resistance. David designed and carried out his own investigation.
