

The CAIRB at Manor Primary School is attached to the mainstream school and has places for up to 8 pupils with communication and interaction difficulties. It is staffed by a team of skilled and experienced teachers and teaching assistants.



The CAIRB offers children an Autism friendly environment with a curriculum tailored and adapted to suit individual needs and abilities. Each child has a carefully planned and managed curriculum aimed at helping them to access education, life skills and the mainstream classroom. Children are provided with individual workstations that help minimize distractions and help them to focus on the task in hand. The CAIRB has areas of low level stimulation and a visual component to all areas of learning. We work closely with the Educational Psychologist and the C&I Team and provide Outreach Support to schools in the Ivybridge Learning Community .



CURRICULUM PROVISION

- A wide and varied curriculum adapted to needs and abilities of the individual.
- Carefully managed and monitored access from mainstream to the CAIRB.
- Multi-sensory approach to learning.
- Enhanced transition from preschool, between classes and onto secondary school.
- Individual Education Plans for each child with progress tracked and targets reviewed.
- Small social skills groups.

THERAPIES OFFERED

- Riding Therapy at Donkey Sanctuary
- Music Therapy, delivered by a qualified Music Therapist funded by National Lottery funding.
- Close liaison with Speech Therapist and OT.

BEHAVIOUR MANAGEMENT

We use a variety of positive motivators to encourage children to complete activities, including:

Rewards and tokens.

Individual Behaviour Plans with targets.

Personal, Social and Emotional Plans and progress carefully monitored and reviewed.
